#1 Proof of Parent's Income (pick one bullet item below)

- Current check stub and 2013 W-2 form (You must have both.), or
- DHS award letter (*You must have received assistance in 2014.*), or
- Proof of SSI payments, unemployment, etc.



#2 Proof of Social Security Number (Parent & Student)

- Social security card



#3 Proof of US Citizenship (Parent & Student)

- Birth certificate, or
- Passport



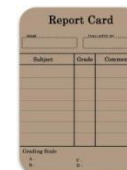
#4 Proof of Detroit Residency (Parent)

- Utility Bill, or
- Driver's License, or
- Phone Bill



#5 School Status (Student School ID is not acceptable)

- Report card, or
- Transcript, or
- Class Schedule



Qualify before you apply?



The Workforce Development Agency has determined that when a Michigan Works! Agency (MWA) includes areas covered by more than one Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL); the higher LLSIL amount shall be used for the whole MWA. The following tables provide metropolitan and non-metropolitan family income levels.

NOTE: For a particular family size, the figure provided is either 70 percent of LLSIL, or the poverty level, whichever is the greater of the two figures.

Poverty Levels for Metropolitan Areas

Family Size	Poverty Income Level 70 Percent of LLSIL Metropolitan
1	\$11,490 (<i>poverty</i>)
2	\$15,510 (<i>poverty</i>)
3	\$20,635
4	\$25,475
5	\$30,061
6	\$35,163
For each additional member over 6 add:	\$5,102

You must meet the above guidelines or are currently receiving DHS assistance to apply.
